Keskkonnaamet declares that AS TREV-2 Grupp (registry code: 10047362) (address Teemeistri tn 2, Nõmme linnaosa, Tallinn, Harju maakond, 10916) an application for amendment of environmental permit No L.MK/321996 for extraction of mineral resources submitted by the Minister on 08.12.2023 in the mining claim of Maleva IV gravel quarry has been accepted for processing by the Environmental Board. The application accepted is registered in the Environmental Decisions information System EAGLE 08.12.2023 with number DM-126644-1, corrected application 11.03.2024 with number DM-126644-7. AS TREV-2 Grupp mines Maleva IV gravel quarry under building gravel extraction permit No L.MK/321996 (the permit is valid until 17.07.2027). As of 28.11.2023, the gravel quarry of Maleva IV has a residual quarry of 123.7 ash m3 of construction gravel, of which the extracted stock is 114.7 ash m3. Since during the term of validity of the permit it is not possible to issue the entire stock in the quarry and to organise the quarry, the extension of the extraction permit is applied for for by 15 years on the basis of subsections 67 (1) and (5) of the Rural drought Act. No other substantive changes are requested to the existing extraction permit. The proposed Mount IV Maleva allotment is located in Lääne-Viru County, Tapa Parish, in the village of Kõrveküla, on a privately owned cadastral unit called Järve (cadastral code 40001:003:1180). The area of the proposed mining claim is 3.67 ha and the area of the service plot of the proposed mining claim is 3.67 ha. The area extension of the mining claim and its service plot is not applied for. The proposed mining allocation includes the 6 blocks of active supply of construction gravel for the Maleva gravel deposit (registry card No 0506 of the Mineral resources Register) and the existing mining reserve for Maleva IV gravel quarry (permit No L.MK/321996; permit holder AS TREV-2 Grupp; permit valid until 17.07.2027). The service area of the proposed mining claim is entirely the same as that of the existing Maleva IV gravel guarry mining claim. The proposed mining claim and its service area adjoins the directly existing Maleva V gravel quarry in the north-west (permit No L.MK/329934; permit holder Metropol Group OÜ; permit valid until 23.10.2032) with the mining claim and its service area and the Maleva quarry existing in the north-east (permit No 2/2005; permit holder OÜ Aigren; permit valid until 23.05.2030) with the mining claim and its service area. The technical restoration of the mining claim shall be carried out in parallel with mining and biological restoration shall be carried out after completion of the extraction if full technical restoration of the entire area has taken place. The gravel quarry of chess vessel IV is restored to woodland. Compliance of an application for an environmental permit with the requirements provided for in the General Part of the Environmental Code Act and the Earth's Crust Act has been verified by the Environmental Board and the Land Board, the authorised processor of the list of mineral deposits in the environmental register. The application complied with the requirements.
