The Environment Agency notifies that SANDPIT OÜ (registry code: <u>11318414</u>) (address: Mäe 7, 48105 Põltsamaa) is applying for an amendment to the mining authorisation No. TARM-058 for the deposit of the sandy quarry of Väg II.

The mountain allocation of the fast II sandy quarry is located in the rural district of Tartu in the village of Selgis in the state-owned cadastral parcels of Väg's sandy quarry K2 (cadastritus 86101:004:0038) and Väg's quarry 2 (cadastritus 86101:004:0043) in the field of the sandy-Selgis (reg.nr 0224).

The mountain allocation of the peaks II is 4.47 ha and the service area of the mountain allocation is 4.91 ha. As of 01.01.2017, the active consumption of building sand associated with mining reserves was 176 thousand m³, of which 156 thousand m³ are mined and the active consumption of aggregate sand was 212 thousand m³, of which 127 thousand m³ are mined. An average annual extraction rate of 20 thousand m³ is requested. The purpose of the mineral resource is construction, road construction and renovation. The period of validity of the authorisation applied for shall be 15 years.
