The Environment Agency States that the request for extension of the environmental permit for the extraction of the mineral resources of the Miila sand quarry submitted by Lasila Betoon (registry code: 10128422) (address: Lasila, village of Lasila, Municipality of Rakvere, County of West Viru, 44401) has been accepted.

The extension of the mining permit is requested in the district of Western Viru, in the municipality of Rägavere, in the village of Kõrma, for the State-owned cadastral unit Miila's quarry (cadastral mark 70201:003:0291). The area includes Miila's sandy deposit (registry card 0072) and a mountain deposit called Miila's sandpasture, an area of 2,93 ha of the mountain deposit and an area of 4,07 ha of the mountain deposit.
