The Environment Agency reports that THE OSAÜHING MOREEN (registry code: <u>10353946</u>) (address Piiritoa, Kaavere village, Põltsamaa vald, 48006 Jõgevamaa) submitted an application for authorisation to exploit the mineral resources of the mountain deposit of the Reastvere V sandy quarry.

The purported mountain allocation for the Reastvere V sandy quarry is located in Jõgeva, Jõgeva, Jõgeva, in the village of Reastvere, in private land, in the cadastral parcels of Sõstraplu (cadastral mark 81001:001:0478, register number 1637335) and rye (cadastral mark 81001:001:0479, register number 1637335) in the pasturgeon area (registry card 0267).

The area of the mountain deposit for the quarry of Reastvere V applied for is 2.58 hectares and that of the service area for the mountain deposit is 2.58 hectares. As of 01.07.2017, the active consumption of building sand associated with mining reserves was 424 thousand m3, of which 294 thousand m3 are mined. The average annual rate of mineral extraction is requested to be 20 thousand m3. The quantity of overburden is 65 thousand m3, of which the quantity of soil is 10 thousand m3. The exploitation of mineral resources is the construction and construction of roads. The period of validity of the authorisation applied for shall be 15 years.
