Notice of initiation of a prospecting permit procedure

The Environment Agency publishes a notice pursuant [to paragraph 30\(2\) of the Land Law \(MaaPS\)](#).

The Environment Agency States that the application for authorisation to PROSPECT for a music research room submitted by as TREV-2 Group (registry code: [10047362](#)) (address Pärnu mnt 463, Tallinn, Harju County, 10916) (registered under document management system of the Environment Agency under number 12-2/18/1416) has been accepted.

The geological survey is requested in the village of music in Harju County, Saue County, Kernu Metropion 5 (cadastral Identifier 29701:005:0190), which is owned by the Republic of Estonia, managed by the Ministry of the Environment and approved by the State Forest Management Centre. The area covered by the requested survey room is 43.07 ha. The geological study shall be carried out in order to clarify the possibilities of exploiting and extracting material (sand and gravel) present in the music research room. This is a consumable stock survey, which plans to build up up to 21 wells and up to 21 exploration cavities. The research depth is up to 7 m. for the sake of completeness, the study plans to carry out the following ad hoc work: sediment clearance, filtration, the rock composition of the gravel blades. The survey is carried out by AS TREV-2 Group (registry code 10047362, address Pärnu mnt 463, Tallinn, Harju County, 10916).

The application for authorisation to prospect and other relevant documents can be consulted at the nearest Office of the Environment Agency (tel 674 4804, e-mail info@keskkonnaamet.ee).

Until such time as a decision is taken to grant or refuse authorisation for a prospecting operation, any person shall have the right to submit reasoned proposals and objections to the Environment Agency. Proposals and objections may be submitted orally or in writing to the e-mail address pohja@keskkonnaamet.ee or to the postal address Viljandi mnt 16, 11216 Tallinn.

The draft decision to grant or refuse authorisation for prospecting shall be further notified by the Environment Agency in the Official Gazette Ametlikud Teadaanded.
