The Environment Agency States that the application for mining authorisation submitted by OÜ Šeiker teed (registry code: <u>14040730</u>) (address: Regione Rapla, Municipality of Kohila, village of Sutlema, Metsapunkt tee 7, 79710) was accepted.

Authorisation to exploit the mineral resources of a tika gravel quarry is sought for the land registry units Aama (cadastral identification 42701:002:0014), privately owned, in the Tika of Maidla in the County of Märjamaa (registry card 0043).
