The Environment Agency reports that the application for authorisation to prospect for the Urissaare III exploration room submitted by OÜ of Mineral resources (registry code: <u>14212964</u>) (address Kuusiku tee 18-13, Loo alevik, Jõelähtme Municipality, 74201 Harju County) 06.04.2018 (adjusted application under document management system 07.05.2018 No 12-2/18/5271-3 of the registered Environment Agency) has been accepted.

The request for a geological survey shall be made in the municipality of Häädemeeste, Pärnu, in the villages of Leina, Krundiga, Urissaare and Orajõe, on state-owned land with a Põdra (cadastritus 84801:004:0768), Altvälja (cadastritus 21301:001:0417), Altväli (cadastritraid 21302:002:0116), Lombimaa (cadastritus 21302:002:0117 and Luha of the Ministry of Agriculture), The test room applied for consists of five solvent units, the total area served by the test room being 38.56 ha. The purpose of the study is to conduct a survey on mineral consumption in order to determine the distribution of mineral resources (sand, gravel), the thickness of the useful layer, the quality and the conditions of extraction.
