The research room for Kaise III is located in the town of Pärnu, in the municipality of Lääanna, in the village Kanamardi, in the cadastral block Varbla, which belongs to the Republic of Estonia, in the town of Varbla, region 65 (cadastral mark 86302:003:0058). The area covered by the survey room is 9.56 ha. The proposed study aims to assess the distribution and quality of the sand used as an earth and to assess the mountainous conditions of extraction. The study plans to build up to 5 wells and up to 16 exploration wells. Research depth up to 9 m is further planned: water level measurement, sampling for steel composition, physico-mechanical properties, filtration characteristics, topo-geodetic measurement.
