Notice of initiation of the mining authorisation procedure

The Environment Agency publishes a notice under [paragraph 47\(2\) of the General Law on the Environment \(KeÜS\)](#).

The Environment Agency States that the application for mining authorisation submitted by Mainer OÜ (registry code: [14267391](#)) (address Harju County, Tallinn, Mustamäe County, Mustamäe tee 161-4, 12913) was granted.

Mining authorisation is sought for a privately owned cadastral parcel of ferries (cadastral identification 29201:003:0104) in the village of LAU in the municipality of Kehtna, County Rapla (registry card 0066).

The area of the mountain deposit for the Sillaotsa sandy pasture applied for is 10.64 ha and that of the service area for the mountain deposit is 11.64 ha. The extracted minerals are, according to the application, building sand and the intended use of the minerals is the construction of roads and general roads. According to the application for mining authorisation, as of 05.12.2018, the active consumption of building sand for mining reserves is 75 thousand m³, the passive consumption is 35 thousand m³ and the average annual mining rate for the margin of 75 thousand m³ is, according to the application, 5 thousand m³. Authorisation to exploit mineral resources is sought for a period of 15 years.
