The Environment Agency reports that the Osaühing Eesti Killustik (registry code: 10126848) (address: Jõgeva County, Põltsamaa Municipality, Rõstla village, Rõstla Queen quarry) submitted an application for authorisation to exploit the sandy quarry in BAT II. Mineral extraction is requested in Pärnu County Saarde, Laiksaare village, on 17 sites (CC. 71001:001:0147) in the Laiksaare district, managed by the Ministry of the Environment and an authorised authority by the State Riigimetsa Majandamise Keskus.

The mountain allocation applied for is 40,33 ha and its catchment area is 52,48 ha. Within the limit of the mountain allocation applied for, the active consumption of building sand is 217 thousand m³, of which the extracted stock is 212 thousand m³ and the active consumption of filler sand is 532 thousand m³, of which the extracted stock is 521 thousand m³. An average annual mining rate of 50 thousand m³ is applied for, the exploitation of the mineral is road construction, the mining company is designated as the Estonian chippings. The period of validity of the authorisation applied for shall be 15 years.
