The requested Tammiste sand quarry is located in the municipality of Tammiste in the municipality of Pärnu on the land of Tammiste in the cadastral estate of Surju Province 48 (register number 6818550, cadastral mark 73001:001:1395, intended use of 100% arable land) in the sandstone deposit of Tammiste (register number 0962). The State Treasury is the Ministry of Environment and the Trustee is the State Riigimetsa Majandamise Keskus.

The mountain deposit of the Tammiste sand pasture has an area of 24.79 ha and the service area of the mountain deposit is 24.79 ha.
