Notice of initiation of the mining authorisation procedure

The Environment Agency publishes a notice under [paragraph 47\(2\) of the General Law on the Environment \(KeÜS\)](#).

The Environment Agency States that the request for amendment and extension of the aktsiaselts Tootsi Turvas permit (HARMON-069) for the extraction of the cod-making stock of Kudasoo ("mining permit") submitted by Tootsi turbvas (REGISTRY code: [10021374](#)) (address: Papiniidu tn 5-büroaja 1, Pärnu City, 80010 Pärnu County) (registered under document management system of the Environment Agency under document number 26.03.2019 under document number 12-2/19/281) has been accepted.

The request concerns the modification of the mining allocation for the Kudasoo peat production area of the Rummu (Kudasoo) deposit and the extension of the mining permit for a period of 30 years. The mountain allocation is located in Harju County, Kuusalu village, Rummu, in the State-owned cadastral parcel of peat production area (cadastral identification: 35201:001:0210, register part: 533102).

The area of the mountain allocation applied for is 112,71 ha and the area of that service is 139,92 ha. According to the application, as of 30.09.2018, the active consumption of well-degraded peat on the mountain allocation is 155 thousand t and the stock to be extracted is 150 thousand t, the active consumption of low-enriched peat is 274 thousand t and the stock to be extracted is 274 thousand t. the maximum annual mineral extraction rate is 50 thousand t, the minerals are used in agricultural and heating peat.

The application for authorisation to exploit mineral resources and other relevant documents can be consulted at the nearest Office of the Environment Agency (tel 674 4804, e-mail info@keskkonnaamet.ee).
