The Environment Agency States that the application for a geological exploration licence submitted by Osaühing pro Petraks (registry code: <u>11293867</u>) (address: Pärnu County, Pärnu City, Pärnu City, Jalaka tn 4, 80019) has been accepted.

Authorisation to carry out geological surveys is sought in the municipality of Häädemeeste in Pärnu, Tahkuranna village, for blue II (cadastral mark 84801:004:0308), a private cadastral parcel. The area covered by the requested survey room is 7.37 ha. This is a consumables survey which plans to build up up up to 20 wells with a research depth of up to 7,5 m. the resources under examination are building and filling sands. The period of validity of the authorisation applied for shall be 2 years. The survey is carried out by OÜ mineral exploration.

The application for authorisation to exploit has been examined by the environmental register data processor, the Maa-amet.
