The Environment Agency States that the application for an environmental permit for the extraction of mineral resources submitted by Osaühing Eesti Klustik (registry code: 10126848) (address: Jõgeva County, Põltsamaa Municipality, Rõstla village, Rõstla paekivikarjäär, 48022) was accepted.

The application for authorisation to exploit a gravel quarry is made for private cadastral parcels Rätsepa (cadastral mark 31701:002:0052) and Võhma (cadastral mark 31701:002:0373) in the village urge in the municipality of Kohila in the district of Rapla (register number 975).

The size of the mountain allocation of a gravel quarry on the markets applied for is 7.05 ha and that of the service area of the mountain allocation is 9.05 ha.
