The Environment Agency States that the application for a geological exploration licence submitted by EMG Arendus OÜ (registration code: 14212964) (address: municipality of Kuusalu, Kiiu subbasik, Vana-Narva mnt 11b, 74604) has been accepted.

The geological survey is requested in Harju County, Kuusalu, Valkla County, on the State-owned Tammesaare property (cadastral mark 35201:001:0074). The test room is called the Valkla II test room. The area covered by the requested survey room is 5.29 ha.
